**Motion for Annotation
Of New Critical and Timely Evidence**

1. I apologize for sending letters into chambers, I did not know I could put something into the official record before the defendants could be served, but I received a letter from the clerk saying I should do it this way.
2. Last month on December 9, 2011 I was in an auto accident in which my weakened left hip was fractured, but that is not the issue. The emergency room doctors found a 9mm bullet in my

right hip. I have enclosed the x-ray graphics of the bullet. I was shot at close range with a firearm weapon.

The only time someone could have discharged a bullet into my body without me knowing about it for six years was between the hours of Tuesday, April 4, 2006, 3:04am to Wednesday, April 5, 2006, at 2:55am. During this time my body was temporarily dead from the hypothermia. If someone had shot a gun into my belly while my heart was beating, there would have been blood everywhere and I would have bled out in twelve minutes without immediate medical care. I never bled out because my body was not alive at the time.

4. Since I cannot dig the bullet out of my body as evidence, I hereby attach my body to this motion as evidence. The bullet in my body is not the main issue; it is rather that I did not know about the bullet for six years. However, it explains why the guards took me to the jail's hospital in a wheel chair, as I was paralyzed below the waist and could not stand up.

5. The bullet proves the hypothermic death and the hypothermia death proves the bullet. The bullet proves murder times two, once by the hypothermia and second by a fatal belly gunshot wound. The whole sordid mess just went into the moribund as if it was not already moribund enough.

6. Shattered hip causation from the bullet.

In my complaint I told you "My legs don't work too well." This was before I even knew of the bullet. My right leg never came back after the bullet ricocheted around my hips severing important nerves and things. It took out my ability to have sex and use my bowels too, but my right leg cannot move involuntarily, I have to look down and tell my leg to move. Years of this caused my left leg to carry too much of the load and it began to stress fracture 18 months ago, then the slow speed accident was all that was needed to shatter it. The doctor said yesterday that

I can't do much worse to it; it's as bad as it can get. I need a new bionic titanium hip because I was shot with a gun at point blank range into my belly.

7. Why put a bullet into me?

I am sure there is some idiotic reason for the bullet in my body such as a way to feign my death being other than hypothermia, lest it give away the hypothermic death chamber. This comes from a firsthand witness of these jokers in action. Otherwise I don't have any evidence at this point to defend or rebuke this lunacy or others that will be gleaned from a full and exhaustive investigation.

8. Full Investigation.

The laws surrounding gunshot, crime victims, and evidence laws dictate that an investigation be conducted to hopefully find and identify the shooter. I would prefer to not walk around with a bullet in my body, but so far no one has done anything. My message to these civil servants is that they might want to use that escape clause in their employment contract that allows them to go beyond the rules, policies, and procedures that constrict them to do nothing, that is their agreement that they would put everything on the line, including their life if necessary, to protect and defend the constitution at all costs. When they find out their cohorts are shooting bullets into dead bodies to feign a reason for their murders, they need to put their life on the line because this is what their oath refers to as a time to sound that alarms far and wide.

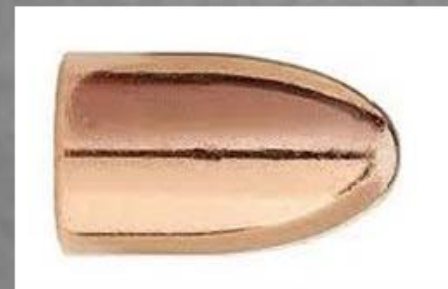
